Year of Cicada Brood X

Cicadas might be a nuisance, but they are not dangerous; they do not bite, spread disease or eat crops. They are also not poisonous to pets.

Shrub of the Year 2021 KODIAK® ORANGE DIERVILLA

If there was an award for most easygoing shrub, Kodiak Orange diervilla would most certainly take first place. This fast growing shrub with native roots will grow just about anywhere in your landscape—sun or shade, moist or dry, even along the deer's path. All summer long, its

small, yellow flowers draw in pollinating bees and hummingbirds. The real show comes in autumn when its foliage glows the most vivid orange-red you could imagine, easily rivaling non-native burning bush.
